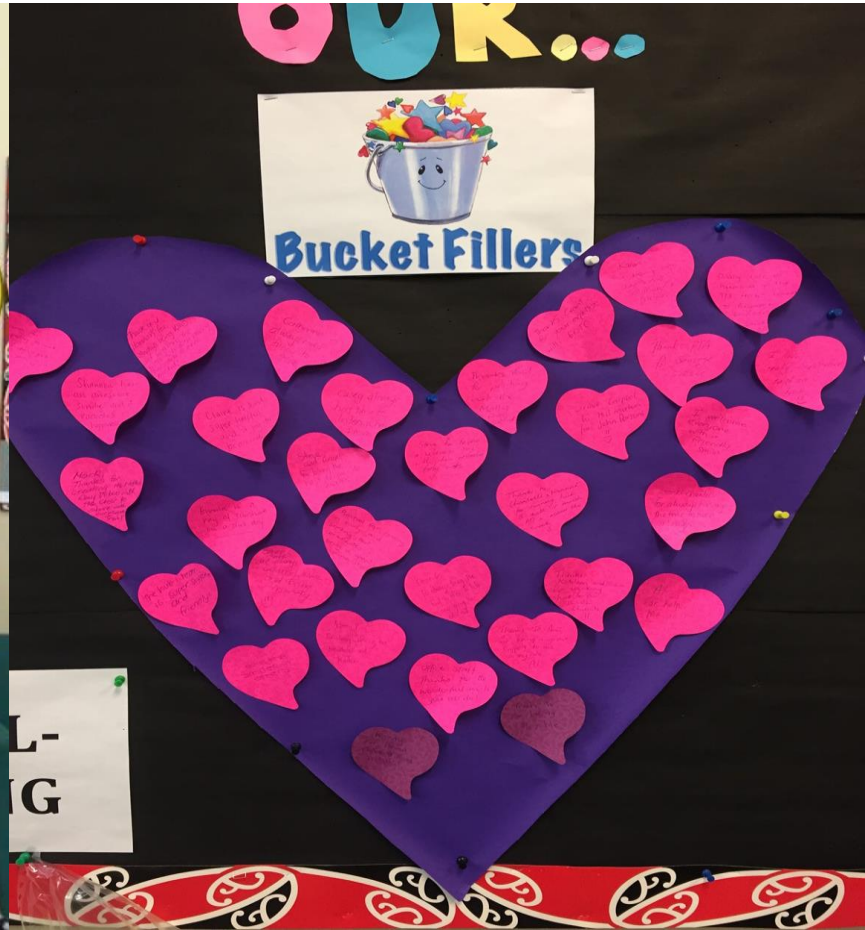
Kindness Hearts
